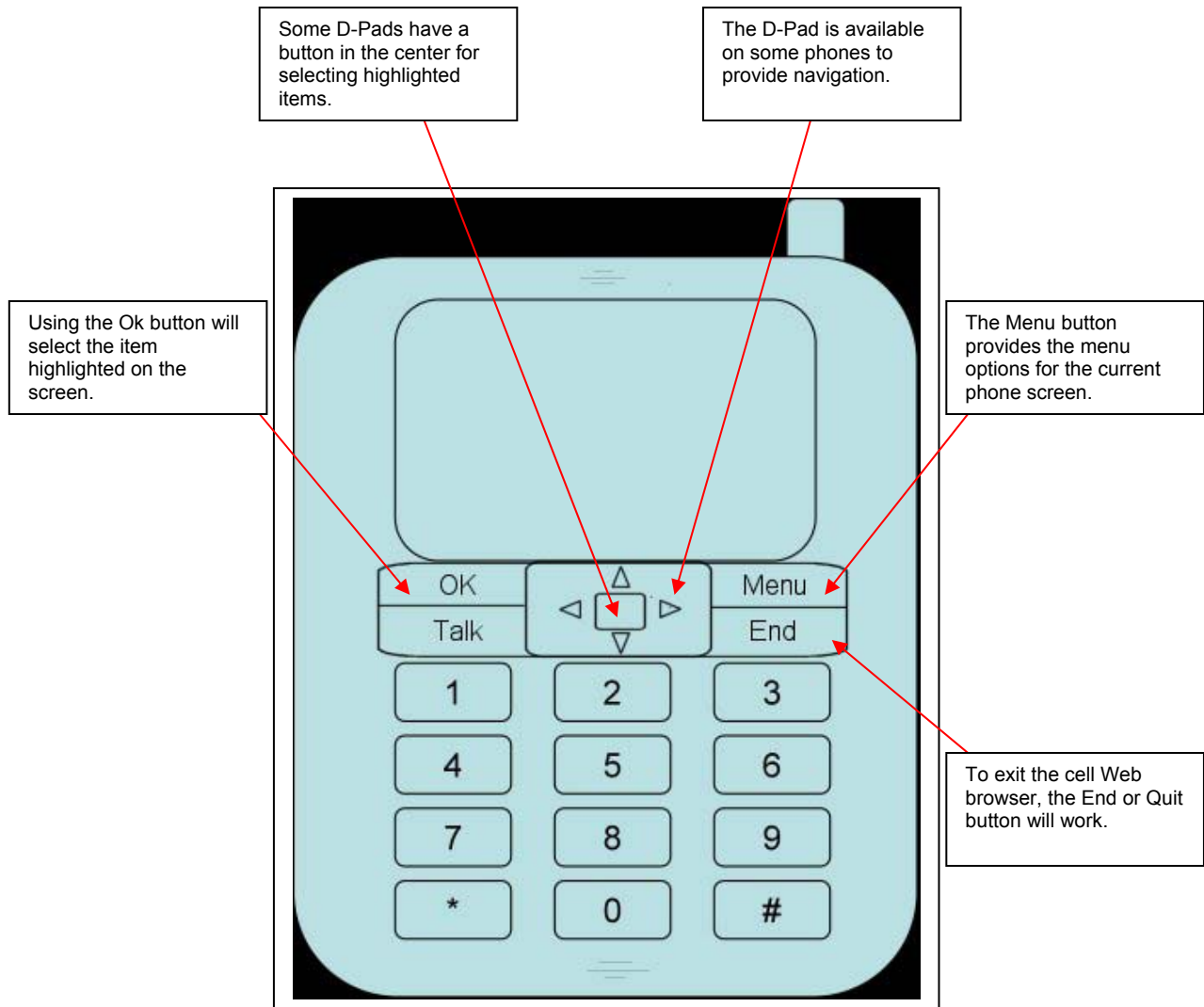


Navigation on a Cell Phone Web Browser

Not all cell phone hardware (button location and screen size) are the same. And the cell phone Web browsers may vary as well. Descriptions provided are general in nature and may include a specific example of how one cell phone happens to work.



Starting the cell phone's Web browser

Cell phones have an option menu to access applications on the cell phone. Included in this menu will be a Web Browser choice (sometimes called "Web", "Internet", etc). Choosing this option will normally prompt you whether you want to connect to the internet. You should choose "yes".

Entering a Web address (URL)

Once the Web Browser has been started, the phone menu will provide a way to enter a URL. This is normally a "menu" button on the cell phone to access Web Browser options such as "Go to URL", "Bookmark page", "View Bookmarks", etc. When you chooses "Go to URL" option you will be prompted to enter a URL. Enter the URL via the cell phone's key pad <http://cell.studytogo.com> .

Self-Quiz

The self-quiz is a random drawing of 3 questions from our pool of questions for the given chapter. At the end of the quiz is a summary of how well you did. For each multiple choice or true/false question there are a series of possible answers marked as A, B, C, D, or E. After you select the correct answer on their phone by navigating to the selection (which is highlighted) and pressing an "OK" or select button on the phone. You will be presented with a page that states if the answer was "Correct" or "Incorrect". On an "Incorrect" response the question is repeated, as well as the incorrect answer, correct answer, and any feedback. Select the button "Next Question" at the bottom of the page to continue to the next question. This is repeated for 3 questions and then you are provided a summary of the quiz. After reading the summary, you can try a "New Quiz" or "Chapter Menu".

Key Terms

A list of key terms for the chapter is listed when you choose the "Key Terms" option. When you select a Key Term, the Key Term and definition are listed on the screen. When done reviewing the key term and definition, you can select the "Back to List" to return to the Key Term list. When done studying the Key Terms, you can select the "Chapter Menu" to exit key terms.

Flashcards

You are provided a definition for a key term in which you must test their knowledge on what the correct key term is. When you feel you have a confident answer, click on the "View Key Term" button to display the key term. You can then proceed to the next definition or select to go back to the chapter menu.
