



Solving a Linear Inequality: Problem Type 2

• Example 1

Solve the inequality

$$7x + 3 \leq 17$$

To isolate x in this inequality, we first subtract 3 from both sides.

$$7x + 3 - 3 \leq 17 - 3$$

$$7x \leq 14$$

Next, we divide both sides by 7.

$$\frac{7x}{7} \leq \frac{14}{7}$$

$$x \leq 2$$
